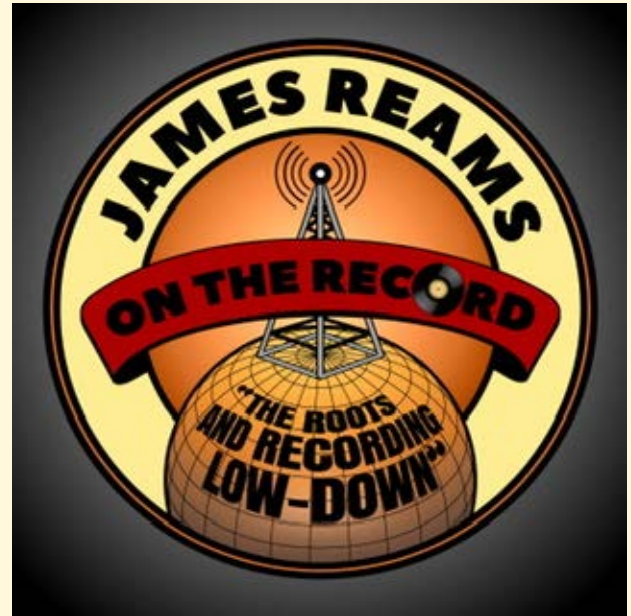

He was the inspiration for part of the soundtrack that Buddy Woodward and I recently created for an upcoming documentary film, *The Holstein Dilemma*. The great actress Isabella Rossellini even makes an appearance. Almost all male Holsteins alive today can be traced back to two bulls from the 1960s, and the film explores how that has affected the breed.

The film is dedicated to all the people that want to preserve Heritage Breeds. 21% of the world's 8000 livestock breeds are in danger of extinction, and if it weren't for the folks working to preserve them, the situation would surely be much worse. 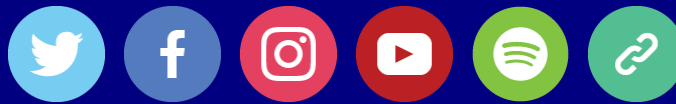
